What is the blight process?

Once a homeowner has been notified/property posted of blight conditions, they have 5 days to correct the violation. After that time, the City will have the violation corrected and assess the cost on the homeowner/property taxes.

How do I obtain a gun permit?

Gun permits are only processed by the Chief of Police and can only be issued to City of Yale residents. Township residents must contact the County Sheriff in Port Huron.

Does the City have a Facebook page?

The City does not have a Facebook page but the City of Yale Police Department does have a Facebook page.

What is the Snow Ordinance and when is it in effect?

The Snow Ordinance is effective in Dec, Jan, Feb, Mar. During this period it is unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to park any motor vehicle on the travel portion of paved streets, or the paved right-of-way of said streets, between the hours of 2:30 AM and 6:00 AM. The fine is \$50.00, payable to the City of Yale, at City Hall.

When is Traffic Court?

The 72nd District Court Traffic Hearings are held on the first Friday of the month in City Hall. Call 810-985-2083 for specific case/hearing information. ***(City Hall is strictly a satellite location. We have no connection to court information, scheduling or payment of fines. Those must be handled through the court.)***
